


## ACCESSING THE USER MANUAL

You can access the user manual in the app by clicking on the icon  in the top right at the start of module installation. If the module is already installed, go to the “Settings” tab in the “Water level regulator” sub-menu.

## REMINDER

- Please observe the installation and operating conditions in the user manual. You can download this manual through the MyIndygo app.
- POOL LEVEL is exclusively for use with private family pools.
- This device needs to use the LRMB-POOL or LRMB-10 radio gateway.

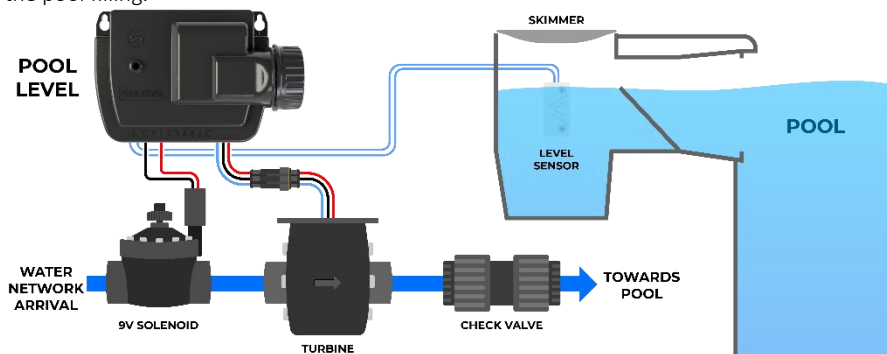
## 1 – Overall presentation

POOL LEVEL is an automatic filling kit consisting of a control module, a level sensor, and a 9V solenoid valve<sup>1</sup>. POOL LEVEL operates on battery and allows triggering pool filling based on a level determined by the sensor.

Your data is recorded and communicated via the MyIndygo application.

## 2 – Installation

1. Unscrew the POOL LEVEL cap and insert a 9V battery type 6LR61 or 6AM6 (not provided). Ensure to securely close the cap to maintain the module's waterproofing.
2. Install the level sensor vertically inside the skimmer, with the highest metal part determining the desired maximum water level. Remove the protective layer from the adhesive and stick it inside the skimmer to place the level sensor there.
3. Connect the level sensor cable to your POOL LEVEL control unit.
4. Connect the module to a 9V solenoid valve output. This allows for the activation/deactivation of the pool filling.



<sup>1</sup> The solenoid valve can be sold separately depending on the POOL LEVEL kit model.

5. Install the turbine following the solenoid valve.
6. Connect the turbine and the POOL LEVEL using the quick connector.
7. We recommend adding a check valve after the turbine.

### 3 – Initial set up

1. Download the MyIndygo app (or another SOLEM-compatible app) to your smartphone.
2. Open the app and create your account.
3. Enter your swimming pool settings and locate it.
4. Check that your Bluetooth is enabled on your phone and that you have an internet connection during the installation.



#### ASSOCIATION WITH A LR-MB-POOL GATEWAY (Remote control via Internet)

1. Install and connect the LR-MB-POOL gateway inside the home in an area with WiFi cover. Ideally, you should install it in a room looking out onto the pool.

#### IMPORTANT!

LR-MB-POOL works using 2.4 GHz WiFi. If you have a 5 GHz WiFi, please also activate the 2.4 GHz bandwidth on your modem.

2. Position yourself within Bluetooth range of the LR-MB-POOL gateway and launch the installation on the app. Following installation, wait one (1) minute and check the LED indicating Internet connection switches to green.
3. Position yourself within Bluetooth range of POOL LEVEL sensor and launch the installation. Follow the instructions.
4. Once installation is complete, the app runs a communication test between the module and the LR-MB-POOL gateway. If this test fails five times in a row, move LR-MB-POOL closer or position it elsewhere to improve radio communication with POOL LEVEL.
5. Once the installation is complete, wait approximately 1 hour before the first data is uploaded.

#### CONFIGURING ALERTS (on the web platform myindygo.com)

1. On a web browser, enter the address: <https://myindygo.com> and log in.
2. In the Alerts tab of the left sidebar, configure the alerts and validate.
3. To modify / add other email addresses for receiving alerts, click on the profile link at the bottom of the left sidebar.

#### GRANT PERMISSION TO YOUR POOL INSTALLER TO ACCESS YOUR DATA

Your pool installer can help you manage your pool by accessing its data.

1. Your professional sends you an access request to the email address of your account. You can then authorize them to access your pool.otre professionnel vous envoie une demande d'accès sur l'adresse mail de votre compte. Vous pouvez alors l'autoriser à accéder à votre piscine.
2. You can accept or decline this invitation by clicking on the checkbox of your choice in the invitation email.
3. You can also manage this access right at any time by going to your user profile (bottom left) on the platform <https://myindygo.com> and clicking on the Professional tab.
